



Autistic vs Neurotypical

Autistic Brain

Biologically incapable of feeling emotion.

Uses technically accurate words.

Interested only in information.

Speaks factually, without emotion.

Prefers monologue to dialogue.

Unaware of nonverbal communication.

Oblivious to how perceived by others.

Cannot be emotionally available.

Spontaneity not possible.

Always direct and forthright.

Neurotypical Brain

Highly motivated by emotion.

May use vague words and idle phrases.

Connects emotionally while talking.

Emotional inflection in voice.

Enjoys dialogue.

Aware of nonverbal communication.

Social awareness.

May be emotionally supportive.

Tends to enjoy spontaneity.

Can be indirect and subtle.

***These differences are irreconcilable.
The autistic brain is what it is and cannot be changed.
So too is the neurotypical brain.***
